How has Gg's House been doing to fulfill this dream?

Gg's House was able to bring some of these things to life in our current location but on a smaller scale. Our volunteers have been able to do the following:

Efficient Inventory Organization Enough space for organized and safe storage of donations: Medical Equipment, School Supplies, Hygiene, Household, Clothing & More.	01
Functional Kitchen A space for meal preparation and culinary education.	02
Second-Hand Store A dedicated area for job training and skill-building.	03
Laundry Facilities Facilities for our homeless friends to wash their clothes.	04
Hygiene Facilities Access to showers and restrooms for basic hygiene needs.	05
Shelter Space Room for a large tent for shelter during extreme weather.	06
Community Garden A garden space for responsibility and fresh produce with a few chickens.	07
Multipurpose Conference Room A space for workshops serving our clients and community.	08

Efficient Inventory Organization (1) Our volunteers are getting organizing to down to a science to maximize our space. Gg's House through is out growing their current space.

Second- Hand Store (3) Gg's House opened Second Chance Treasures in February 2026 all proceeds support Gg's House. But no job training has been offered to date due to limited hours and program is still being developed.

Laundry Facilities (4) Some of our volunteers have graciously taken items of clients to wash but not very often.

Hygiene Facilities (5) Gg's House is able to have one public restroom open from 10am-1pm Monday-Friday

Shelter Space (6) Temporary Canopy with sides was put up in the outdoor sitting area but due to a wind storm one weekend this winter it was destroyed.

Multipurpose Conference Room (8) Gg's House was able to hold holiday dinners, bingo and a gathering on Sundays. This is by putting items in various places in other parts of the building that will have to be put back after the event. So it takes a lot of planning and time.

Love Story:

Gg's House recently had the privilege of walking alongside a mother—let's call her **Sally**—as she rebuilt her life after surviving domestic violence.

Sally made the decision to leave her abuser and fought to regain custody of her child who spent two years in foster care. She was gradually starting to put her life back together. After she was awarded sole custody, her abuser found them again. To protect her child and herself, Sally fled her home state with only a few clothes. A case worker rushed them to the airport, and in the chaos of escaping danger, they had to leave everything behind, including their beloved kitty.

Sally's sister in Oregon took them in temporarily while they searched for housing. Around Christmas, her sister reached out to Gg's House for help. Pinky invited them to the Gg's House Christmas Party, for things Sally would need during a difficult time. The moment Sally walked through the door, she felt something she hadn't felt in a long time—safety, welcome, and genuine kindness.

Sally felt the need to start volunteering at Gg's House as she felt it was a safe place to give back and heal from her trauma. Sally is building a new life for her child and herself. She believes in the welcoming and helping anyone and she always says "It costs nothing to be kind"

Gg's House is honored to have supported her with essential items, but even more honored that she found a place where she felt safe, valued, and loved after everything she endured.
